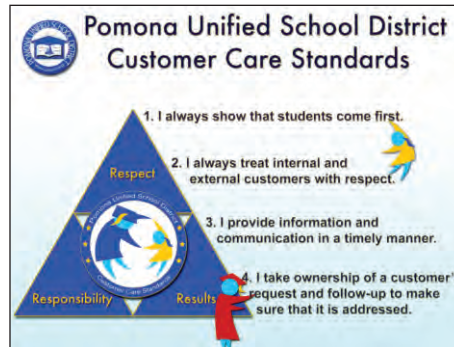

## A Message From Village Management

### Our Village is Growing

As members of our Educational Village Community you may have noticed a little extra activity this summer as our Village begins the transformation needed to embrace and welcomes the addition, expansion and/or collocation of 3 major tenants and community service providers.

Pomona Unified School District's Child Development Program, the largest provider of children and family services in the Pomona Valley is moving its "direct services" units into a new larger space (the Old Department Store Space) in the front of The Village to improve customer access to services. Currently, the new Child Development Service Center is undergoing a face-lift and it is expected that this move will be completed before September 2010.

The Crittenton Program – provides off-site counseling and support services for Pomona children, youth and their families, is expanding their current space of 1,000 sq. ft. to over 6,000 sq. ft. in The Village to better support their clients. They are about to start a major renovation project on approximately 3,500 sq. ft. of space directly across from the Village Theater. Crittenton recently moved into Suite 180 and is looking to expand their program when Child Development moves from Suite 178. Crittenton expects that their renovation across from the Theater will be completed this fall 2010.

Work will soon begin on the Old Savon Building to renovate 8,000 sq. ft. for a new member to our Village Community – The Pomona Community Health Center. The Center works with the Pomona Valley Hospital to extend health services to many children and families in the greater Pomona Valley. The Health center project will likely be completed later this fall 2010.

### GENERAL SAFETY PROCEDURES for the Village @ Indian Hill

The following list will help in deterring dangerous and unsafe conditions:

1. Exits should not be obstructed with furniture, supplies, or any other equipment.

3. Liquids (beverages) must be kept away from electrical equipment.
4. Keep and maintain your work area clean and clutter-free. Do not let combustible material accumulate in and around your office.

6. Read and obey all signs, labels, danger notices and all other warnings.
7. Apply any other cautionary steps you regard important for avoiding hazardous conditions.
